

**Yard Waste Schedule**

Monday and Tuesday – North of SR 100 and West of the Intracoastal Waterway

Wednesday and Thursday – South of SR 100

Note: Exact pick-up day will vary with volume of material and truck load.

Have your yard waste out on the first day.

**Solid Waste (Garbage) Pick-Up Schedule**

Monday and Thursday - South of SR 100 to South 28<sup>th</sup> Street including Pebble Beach Village

Tuesday and Friday - North of SR 100, West of the Intracoastal Waterway, and South of Gamble Rogers State Park

Schedule does not vary with major holidays – expect pick-up regardless.

**Solid Waste Rules**

Container capacity should not exceed 32 gallons

Plastic bags should be securely tied

Containers should be roadside by 7 AM the morning of your pick-up

Place containers within 6 feet of the road

Large furniture must be broken down into pieces that can be easily handled by one man

**Recyclable Pick-up Schedule**

Wednesday – South of SR 100 to South 28<sup>th</sup> Street including Pebble Beach Village

Thursday – North of SR 100, West of the Intracoastal Waterway, and South of Gamble Rogers State Park

**Recyclable Rules**

Recycling is mandatory in Flagler Beach per Ordinance 2008-03

Bins are available for free by calling (386) 517-2017 to arrange delivery

All recyclables can be mixed together in the same bin

Bins should be roadside by 7 AM the morning of your pick-up

Bins should be within 6 feet of the road

Acceptable Recyclables

Steel, tin, and aluminum cans (empty and rinsed)

Glass (NOT broken, like a mirror or picture frame)

Newspapers, Magazines, and Phone Books

Cardboard (also clean pizza boxes)

Paper and Shredded Paper (bagged so it is contained)

Hard Plastics or with a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 label

Unacceptable Recyclables

Foam Rubber

Styrofoam / Bubble wrap

Hardcover Books (can remove covers and recycle inside pages )

Paper towels, Tissues

Light plastics, like cellophane

\*\*Plastic bags are NOT recyclable. Please take them to your neighborhood grocery store.\*\*

**White Goods**

Stoves, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers, etc. will be picked up free of charge.

Call the Sanitation Department to schedule a pick-up at (386) 517-2017.

**Refrigerators and freezers must have the door removed prior to placement in the street to prevent a suffocation hazard!**

**Household Hazardous Waste**

Transport it to the Flagler County Recycling & Household Hazardous Waste Landfill

(see flow chart inside) OR Bring it to Flagler Beach Library, 315 S. 7th Street, during the

Household Hazardous Waste Cleanout Campaign held annually in May.
