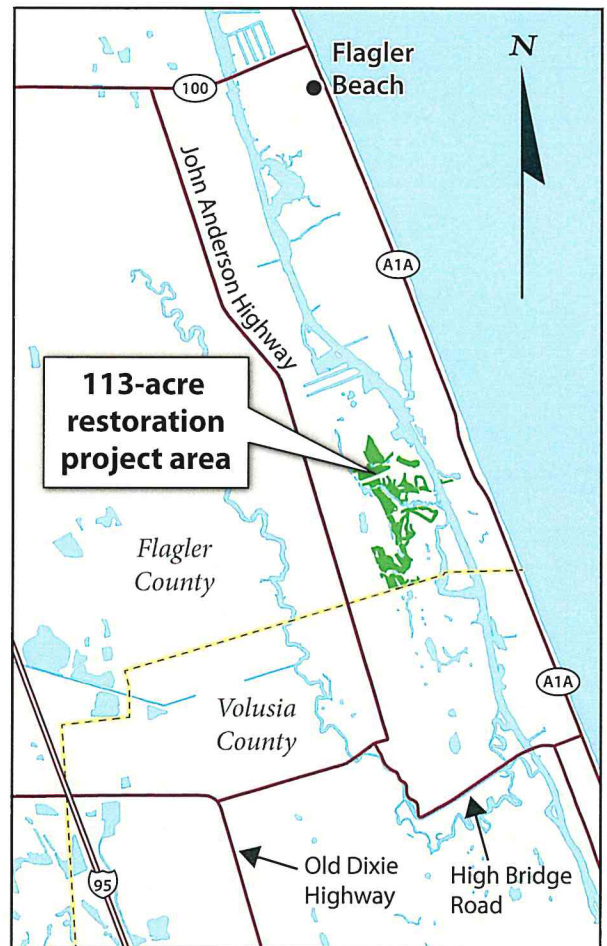

SJRWMD is currently partnering with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and Florida Department of Environmental Protection and Florida State Park System to restore dragline ditch-impacted wetlands in Flagler County. The restoration will consist of moving the spoil piles back into the ditches and grading the spoil to match the elevation of nearby remnants of natural wetland.

These interactive public workshops will offer opportunities for stakeholder comment, engagement with project partners, and the ability for the public to provide input on the footprint of the project.
