**Accepts:**  
**Yard Waste:**  
 grass clippings, palm "boots"  
 branches - no longer than 5 feet or  
 greater than 5 inches in diame-  
 ter  
 palm fronds, stems toward street  
  
 Place small, loose items in 32 gal-  
 lon (max) container or cardboard  
 box that one man can lift (50 lbs)  
 NO PLASTIC BAGS or PAPER BAGS  
  
 Limit: Eight 32 gallon containers  
 Or one stacked pile, 3'Wx6L'x6'H  
 ~ 4 cubic yards  
  
 Pick-up Schedule: On a weekly  
 basis, Monday through Friday.  
 If Pick-up Limit is exceeded, or for  
 a vacant lot, call Sanitation for a  
 special pick-up: Whole truck load,  
 \$144.23  
 ½ truck load (12½ cubic yards),  
 \$ 72.11

**Accepts:**  
**Yard Waste**  
 Land Clearing Debris (trees, stumps, brush, earth, soil, sod, etc.)  
  
*Flagler CDS Fee: \$5 per cubic yard*      *ELS Fee: \$5 per cubic yard*  
  
**Construction Materials**  
 plumbing fixtures, concrete, brick, lumber, plywood, plaster, PVC pipe,  
 flooring, wire, roofing material, pallets, electric wire, plastic sheeting,  
 light fixtures, light bulbs (but no fluorescent)  
  
*Flagler CDS Fee: \$8.50 per cubic yard*      *ELS Fee: \$48 per ton*  
  
Call for pick-up/drop off instructions

**Accepts:**  
 Fluorescent lights, tires, paint  
  
**Hazardous Materials:**  
 batteries, aerosols, fertilizers,  
 pesticides, herbicides,  
 automotive waste, acids,  
 pool chemicals  
**Electronic Waste:** flat screen TV  
 fax machine, cell phone  
 common household electrics  
 (iron, hair dryer, radio, clock,  
 toaster)  
 Boating and marine supplies  
  
Call for drop off instructions  
*Fee: No Charge*

**Accepts:**  
**Biomedical Waste:**  
 Hypodermic Needles  
  
 Lancets for people and / or  
 pets  
  
Call for pick-up/drop off  
 instructions  
  
*Fee: \$3/quart, \$5/gallon*



**Flagler CDS Rejects:**  
 Pressure treated wood  
 Fluorescent lights, tires, paint  
 Hazardous Materials  
 Biomedical Waste

**ELS also Accepts:**  
 Pressure treated wood  
 Furniture  
 TVs, including non-flat screen

**Rejects:**  
 Construction Materials  
 TVs that are not flat screen  
  
 Large Appliances (White Goods)  
 Note: Flagler Beach will pick  
 up, see back page)  
 Biomedical Waste

 with Permits to do business in the City.

**CONSIDER THIS:**

- ◆ It is the homeowner's responsibility to ensure that parked vehicles do not impede the maneuverability of the truck drivers to do their job.
- ◆ Putting your garbage and recycle bins curbside the night before your scheduled pick-up invites wild animals to scatter the contents. And if it rains over-night, the City pays more \$\$\$ because disposal fees are based on weight.
