

Yard Waste

- Yard waste must be curbside by 7 AM and placed within 6 feet of the roadway.
- Residential customers are allowed up to eight 65-gallon containers or one brush pile no larger than 3 x 6 x 6 feet or 50 pounds. If your amount exceeds this limit, a special pick-up fee may be charged, as determined by the Sanitation Supervisor.
- Do not place any yard waste in plastic or paper bags.
- Place grass clippings or palm “boots” in boxes or other open containers.
- Stack palm fronds with stems facing toward the street.
- Yard waste placed in alleys or vacant lots will not be picked up.
- **Vacant lot owners** may contact the Sanitation Department at 386-517-2017 for special pick-up service and be charged accordingly as determined by the Sanitation Supervisor.

Monday & Thursday

South of Highway 100 to South 28th St,
Including Pebble Beach Village.

Tuesday & Friday

North of Highway 100,
West of the Intracoastal Waterway, and
South of Gamble Rogers State Park.

Garbage

- Garbage containers should be curbside by 7 AM and placed within 6 feet of the roadway.
- Container capacity should not exceed 65 gallons. Plastic bags should be securely tied.
- Refrigerators, freezers, and large ice chests dangerous to children must have the doors removed.
- Large furniture should be broken down into pieces that can be handled by one person.
- Household hazardous materials can be disposed of free of charge at Flagler County Recycling & Household Hazardous Waste facility at 1700 South Old Kings Road. (386) 517-2075

City Ordinance 86-19 prohibits Sanitation crews from picking up any waste defined as the following:
EARTH, TREES, CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS OR DEBRIS, ROOFING MATERIAL, PLASTER, CONCRETE, or any other substance that may accumulate as a result of building operations or repairs, or as a result of clearing lots or tree removal.

Recycling

- Wednesday is the city wide recycle day.
- Recycling Bins are available to all Flagler Beach residents at no charge. Call 386-517-2017 to arrange delivery.
- Recyclables must be curbside by 7 AM on Wednesdays and placed within 6 feet of the roadway.

The following is a list of recyclables that are collected curbside:

Blue recycling bins are for:

- Glass (labels included)
- Tin products
- Aluminum (aluminum cans, aluminum bottles)

Corrugated cardboard can also be recycled and should be separated from the blue recycling bin.

The following items will not be picked up:

No shoe boxes, no pizza boxes, no paper towels, no toilet paper rolls, no newspaper, no magazines, and no aluminum pans. Plastic and metal (except tin) should be placed with regular trash until further notice.
