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*****GENERAL CONDITIONS*****

The Department of Public Works (386-285-7737) shall be notified 48 hours prior to any excavation. Also notify the City of Flagler Beach Police Department (386-517-2020) and Fire Department (386-517-2010). Coordinate any required inspections for open cuts, sidewalk removal/replacement, and/or curb cuts with the Public Works Department. All open pavement cuts shall conform to City code and be completed within three (3) calendar days unless otherwise specified on this permit. All other repairs and restoration will be performed within seven (7) calendar days to as good or better than the conditions before the construction started.

Public Works must be notified upon completion of all restoration so an inspection can be performed. Permittees who do not complete restoration work in a timely manner or do not properly notify the City when complete, may incur future permitting delays and possible monetary charges for any work that the City must do to finish or repair the unfinished or unacceptable work.

The applicant agrees to comply with all City codes and ordinances. The City reserves the right to cancel this permit if the conditions are violated. This permit may be subject to field adjustments to prevent conflict with existing utilities.

No sidewalks, driveways, roadways, or other hard surfaces shall be disturbed unless clearly defined and approved by this permit.

As a result of the work performed defined by this permit, the applicant hereby agrees to sod and restore all damages to the rights-of-way, sidewalks, streets, alleys, pipelines, etc. to the conditions that existed before the work was done, provided that this does not change any provision of Chapter 556, Florida Statutes.

THIS PERMIT BECOMES NULL AND VOID IF WORK OR CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZED IS NOT COMMENCED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS, OR IF THE CONSTRUCTION IS SUSPENDED OR ABANDONED FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS AT ANYTIME AFTER WORK IS COMMENCED.

I hereby certify that I have read and examined this application and know the same to be true and correct. All provisions of laws and ordinances governing this type of work will be complied with whether specified herein or not, the granting of a permit does not presume to give authority to violate or cancel the provisions of any other State or Local law regulating construction or the performances of construction.
